

ONEIDA EDUCATION FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline for Scholarship Application: **Monday, March 16, 2009**

Criteria for eligibility for scholarships:

- Official graduation from Malad High School or Oneida High School during the 2008-2009 school year.
- Acceptance by a university, college, or vocational/technical school accredited by one of the regional college/university accrediting associations.
- Completion of scholarship application, including transcripts and letters of recommendation. **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

Application Process:

- Get application from the high school counselor's office or from the OEF website: www.maladidaho.org/oef.
- Complete application, including all letters of recommendation, prior to deadline of Monday, March 16, 2009. Turn in application to the Malad High School Counselor's Office.
- Include a 1-page (full page) double-spaced Written Statement. Discuss your future educational and vocational/career goals and how you plan to use the scholarship money.
- Request copies of your official transcript of your high school grades and ACT scores from the school counselor's office.
- Get **two** letters of recommendation. **One letter of recommendation must be from a high school teacher from whom you took a class** so he or she can address your academic potential and achievement. (Coaches, administrators, staff, and aides cannot write teacher recommendations unless you took a class from them.)
- Some scholarships have specific requirements for the letters of recommendation; be sure to follow the requirements. Failure to have letters of recommendation that meet requirements will exclude you from consideration for some scholarships.
- The same two letters of recommendation will satisfy the requirements for all the local scholarships for which you apply. You do not have to have different letters for each scholarship as long as you meet any specific requirements.
- Submit **THREE COPIES** of your scholarship application, including all letters of recommendation, to the Malad High School Counselor's Office.

These scholarships will be awarded based on quality of application and how well the applicant meets the criteria. High school grades, ACT scores, and financial need will be considered but will not be the only criteria for many of these scholarships.

Scholarships will be announced at the Senior Awards Assembly in May 2009.

Scholarships must be used within 12 months of award date for education-related expenses. All recipients AND THEIR PARENTS must sign the Scholarship Terms of Agreement.

All scholarship applications require TWO letters of recommendation; one must be from a high school teacher from whom you took a class. Other specifications for letters of recommendations are listed below.

_____ RENTMEISTER SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include good academic record, high financial need, extracurricular activity involvement, community service, intent to attend academic college; one letter of recommendation must be from a community member)

_____ WILLIAM E. RUTTER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include community service; one letter of recommendation must be from a community member)

_____ ROBERT W. WALDRON SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in science and/or math in high school and intent to major in science or math in college; one letter of recommendation must be from a high school science or math teacher)

_____ M. JOE DAVIS SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in history or government classes in high school and intent to major in history or political science in college; one letter of recommendation must be from a high school history or government teacher)

_____ DAVID K. CROWTHER SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include community service; one letter of recommendation must be from a community member)

_____ LUCILLE EVANS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include participation throughout high school in special education)

_____ BRYCE M. ROBBINS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include participation in high school track (top priority) or wrestling)

_____ G.K. MATKIN BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include participation in high school baseball)

_____ RUTH AND ZIVKO ZIVKOVIC SCHOLARSHIPS (criteria include intent to major in horticulture or related field or health-related field; must have one letter of recommendation from a community member)

_____ HELEN SERVOSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in high school English or foreign language classes and intent to major in English or foreign language; must have letters of recommendation from a community member and a high school English or foreign language teacher)

_____ GERALD P. AND HELEN H. THOMAS SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include intent to major in business-related field; must have letter of recommendation from an employer)

_____ GERALD E. WILLIAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in Malad High School athletics)

- _____ ASHLEE ALDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include involvement in many extracurricular activities and high cumulative GPA)
- _____ DEANNA ZIVKOVIC KLEINART MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in government classes in high school and intent to major in political science or pre-law)
- _____ FFA AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include 4 years of agriculture classes in high school, participation in 4 years of FFA, recipient of State Farmer Award, and intent to major in agriculture-related field)
- _____ EDITH JONES THOMAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in business classes in high school and intent to major in business education or secretarial science; must have letter of recommendation from high school business education teacher)
- _____ BOYD THOMAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in science classes or electronics in high school and intent to major in engineering or electronics-related field; preference given to ham radio license holder; must have letter of recommendation from high school science teacher)
- _____ DR. GARTH JAMES SCHOLARSHIP (criteria include excellence in science classes and intent to major in science-related field)

Not all scholarships listed above will be awarded every year. Awarding of a scholarship depends on availability of funding.
