

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MALAD CITY, IDAHO REQUIRING A DETERMINATION OF FEASIBILITY OF THE WATER CONNECTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL, ANNEXATION OF THE PROPERTY, AND PAYMENT OF ALL CONNECTION FEES PRIOR TO ANY PERSON OR BUSINESS ENTITY RESIDING OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF MALAD CITY BEING ALLOWED TO CONNECT TO AND UTILIZE CITY WATER SERVICES AND PROVIDING SAID ORDINANCE BE EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council for the City of Malad City, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1: Prior to any person or business entity residing outside the corporate city limits connecting to and receiving water services from the city culinary system all of the following conditions must be complied with:

- a. The Malad City Council shall determine by formal resolution that sufficient water within the city water system is available and that the project is feasible to service the proposed connection.
- b. The subject property shall be annexed into the corporate city limits of Malad City, State of Idaho.
- c. The applicant shall pay all regular connection fees prior to the installation of the connection and shall pay all subsequent costs and expenses associated with the connection from the city water system to the subject property including but not necessarily limited to, all materials, labor, and equipment costs related to the installation of the water connection to the subject property upon completion of the connection project.


Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and approval by the Mayor and City Council of Malad City, Idaho, and publication as provided by law.
