

ORDINANCE NO. 467

AN ORDINANCE OF MALAD CITY, IDAHO, A POLITICAL AND MUNICIPAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING "REGULATION IV – NEW SERVICE CONNECTIONS" OF ORDINANCE NO. 331 OF MALAD CITY, IDAHO BY ADDING SECTION OR PARAGRAPH FOUR (4); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Malad City, Idaho, deem it necessary for the health, peace, safety, morals, convenience, order and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Malad City to make and adopt certain amendments regarding new connection hookups to the Malad City water and sewer system;

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MALAD, STATE OF IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Regulation IV of Malad City Ordinance Number 331 is hereby amended to include a new section or paragraph four (4) as follows:


4. NEW CONNECTIONS ALONG, ABUTTING, CONNECTING, INTERFERING OR AFFECTING STATE HIGHWAYS. Road surface digging or trenching on state highways for new connections to the Malad City water and sewer system are prohibited unless approved by Malad City. Applicants for new connections to the Malad City water and sewer system wherein the new connection abuts, connects, interferes, interrupts or affects a state highway or which otherwise requires a disruption of a state highway, are hereby required to bore under the highway and bear all

costs associated therewith in addition to any other costs or fees required for a new connection. Applicants for such new connections shall guarantee that such boring does not cause the highway to settle for a subsequent two (2) year period, and shall be liable for the maintenance and repair associated with any such settling. Applicants for such new connections shall comply with all regulations and requirements imposed by the State of Idaho in conjunction with the new connection.

SECTION 2: Except as expressly amended above, the balance of Malad City Ordinance No. 331 is hereby ratified and confirmed, as currently amended, without further change.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and approval by the City Council and Mayor of Malad City, Idaho, and publication as provided by law.
